COACHING STAFF

MARK HARDAWAY – HEAD COACH



Mark Hardaway came to Youngstown State with an extensive background in winning, and it didn't take long for him to immediately make his mark on the Penguins' program.

Hardaway led YSU to a 15-14 record YSU in his first season, the program's best mark in 13 years. The Penguins won more matches in 2012 than they did in their previous three seasons combined, and their 10-win improvement tied for the 10th-best improvement in the country. Further, their 99-spot improvement in the RPI was 15th-best in the country.

The Penguins lost the first match of the season in five sets to immediately hint at an uptick in competitiveness, and they got a huge confidence boost after taking a set from Michigan State the next day on Aug. 25. Hardaway got his first victory on the YSU bench against McNeese State later that afternoon, and the Guins went on to win eight straight matches. That was tied for the third-longest winning streak in school history, and, more impressively, it represented more victories than the program had posted in the previous two seasons combined.

The Guins finished the non-league season with a 10-4 record, and a 5-9 mark in Horizon League play earned them a spot on the conference tournament. It was their first tournament appearance since 2008.

YSU ranked second in the Horizon League in hitting percentage, blocks per set and aces per set. The .212 attack percentage was the best since 1999. Defensively, the Penguins held opponents to a .197 attack percentage, the lowest since the NCAA went to rally scoring in 2001.

On the individual level, junior Missy Hundelt earned All-Horizon League honors as a right-side hitter. Hundelt ranked fourth in the league in kills per set while ranking fifth in double-doubles. A vastly-improved Jenna Cavanaugh led the Horizon League with 1.23 blocks per set, and she set a new school record with 13 block assists against UIC on Sept. 28.

Hardaway came to Youngstown State having been on the bench for 344 victories at the Division I level. He was most recently an assistant at Bowling Green, and he spent his career developing ties in Ohio and throughout the Midwest.

Hardaway spent 24 years as a collegiate coach, with 10 years each as an assistant at Bowling Green and a Division I head coach. He served two stints at BGSU coaching with Denise Van De Walle. He was on her bench for two seasons from 1991-92, and he returned for another eight seasons from 2004-11. In between, he was the head coach for two years at Western Kentucky and eight years at Evansville.

With Hardaway on the bench, Bowling Green went 206-122 and had 25 All-Mid-American Conference selections. The Falcons finished with at least 20 wins in five of those 10 seasons.

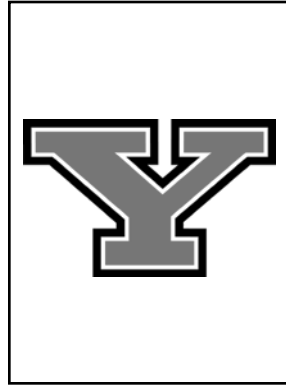
Hardaway earned his first Division I head coaching job in 1993 and proceeded to go 45-27 in two seasons at Western Kentucky. Hardaway coached two All-Sun Belt selections, two all-tournament picks and five academic all-conference honorees in his two seasons with the Hilltoppers.

Hardaway went on to coach Evansville for eight seasons and led the Purple Aces to their first winning season in 10 years in 1998. In 2000,

Hardaway's first head coaching job at the collegiate level came at Defiance College. Prior to that, he spent a year each as an assistant at Pittsburg State and Missouri Southern State College.

Hardaway earned his Bachelor of Science degree in physical education from Missouri Southern State in 1988. He and his wife, Ann, have two sons - Christopher and Matthew.

SARAH SMITH – ASSISTANT



Sarah Smith, a former head coach at the Division II level, is in her first season as an assistant volleyball coach at YSU.

Smith spent the last nine years as the head coach at Division II Shepherd University in Eastern West Virginia. Her tenure at Shepherd was highlighted by a 21-win season in 2009 and her being named the West Virginia Intercollegiate Athletic Conference Coach of the Year. The following year, she was named one of the American Volleyball Coaches Association's Top 30 Coaches Under 30.

Smith led the Rams to 129 wins and a 72-61 mark in conference play during her nine years. Sixteen of her players earned all-conference honors, and one went on to earn AVCA All-Region accolades. Off the court, the Rams earned a team GPA over 3.1 eight times.

Smith was very active off the court. She created what became the Shepherd Women's Athletic Alliance, which brings all women's sports teams together for community outreach and fundraising opportunities. She was the Mountain East Volleyball Coaches Chair and was active on the AVCA All-Region and Division II Head Coaches committees.

Prior to taking over at Shepherd, Smith was a graduate assistant at Minnesota State, Mankato for the 2003 and 2004 seasons. Her duties included training middle blockers, scouting opponents and video analysis. In 2003, the Mavericks finished 20-9 and ranked 20th in the country.

Smith had an outstanding career as a student-athlete at Bryant University. As a four-year starter, Smith led the Bulldogs to four NCAA Tournament appearances and an overall record of 116-45. Smith registered 406 kills on a .340 attack percentage her senior year in 2002 as Bryant advanced to the Sweet 16.

NATALIE BORLAND – ASSISTANT



Natalie Borland is in her second season as an assistant coach at YSU.

Borland was most recently the head coach of the 18 R team at the Varsity Elite Volleyball Club in Canal Fulton, Ohio, where she managed all aspects of practice and matches. As the head coach of the 17 R squad in 2011, her teams won two tournaments and finished as a runner-up in another.

Borland served as a volunteer assistant at Walsh University, her alma mater, for the 2011 volleyball season. The Cavaliers went 27-7 overall and shared the American Midwest Conference championship with a 9-1 record. Walsh also won the Ohio Independent Championships, had five players earn all-AMC honors and three more earn all OIC accolades.

As a collegiate player, Borland earned letters at Wheeling Jesuit, Kent State and Walsh. She was named to the West Virginia Intercollegiate Athletic Conference All-Freshman team in 2006 at Wheeling Jesuit, and she played at Kent State in 2007. Borland then transferred to Walsh where she was an honorable mention all-conference pick as a junior and a first-team selection as a senior.
